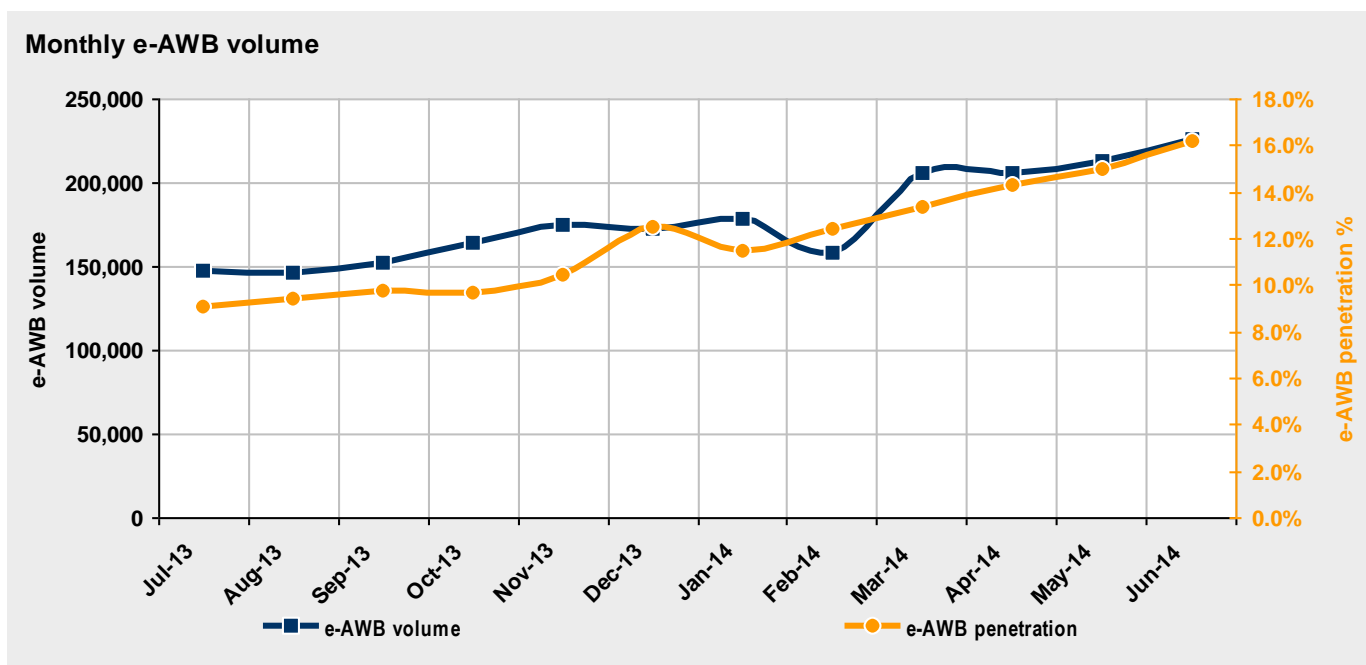

Key progress around the globe

- **India:** All airports in India (including Mumbai, Delhi and Bangalore) are now open for e-AWB. India Customs do not require paper copy of air waybill on export or import.
 - Export: IN Customs require a copy of Packing List, sight original invoice even though details included in Shipping Bill.
 - Import: IN Customs only require HAWB for Customs clearance. Self-Certified copies of the MAWB/HAWB are accepted.
- **Singapore:** SQ's latest effort to expand e-AWB in India, China and parts of Europe (CDG, ZRH, BSL) is paying off, in June SQ penetration stand at 31.5%, +10% up from previous month. SQ plans to cut-over MXP, FCO, CPH and SYD by end of Q3/2014.
- **New Zealand:** Mainfreight Limited is the first freight forwarder to join MeA in New Zealand.
- **Japan:** Thanks to the persistent effort of local community led by the e-AWB working group members, Japan e-AWB penetration has doubled in Q2 to 2.7%. All Japanese airlines as well as the top 3 Japanese freight forwarders have signed the Multilateral e-AWB Agreement (MeA) covering 80% of Japan market.
- **China:** China Cargo Airlines (CK) and China Southern Airlines (CZ) completed e-AWB pilot from Amsterdam to China in close collaboration with Chinese Customs.
- **Chinese Customs in Guangzhou (CAN)** announced that a formal application process will be in place for the carriers to join the e-AWB pilot in Guangzhou by end of July.
- **Taiwan:** China Airlines (CI) and Eva Air (BR) are actively engaging their key customers to adopt e-AWB in Taipei and Kaohsiung. Their effort is paid-off, Taiwan ranks 6th on the leader board in June.
- **Saudi Airlines (SV)** moves ahead with its e-AWB roll-out: HKG and SV key European hubs went live with e-AWB for both import and export in July 2014.
- **Cathay Pacific Cargo (CX)** has begun their efforts to move toward 100% e-AWB out of the US by 2015. CX is currently working closely with their customers at all of their US gateways, in July they experienced 40% growth out of ATL.
- **American Airlines** continues their roll-out to all their major US gateways in June. Local meetings with their customers and business partners were held at LAX, DFW, ORD and MIA. Future meetings in JFK are planned for later this year.
- **Mexico:** At "Expocarga," the biggest Mexican Air Cargo Exhibition, it was announced that **all Mexican Airports are now open to e-AWB outbound. Aeromexico, Cathay Pacific, Delta Airlines and the LAN Group** announced that they are ready to implement e-AWB with their customers out of their locations in Mexico.
- **Ethiopian Airlines (ET)** builds upon the recent opening for e-AWB of Saudi Arabia and has moved its trade lane ADD-JED to 100% e-AWB in June 2014.
